



### ***Program Guidelines***

The Senior Meal Restaurant Program is a voucher program, designed to allow more flexibility in dining location, hours, and menu choices. According to Older Americans Act guidelines the following individuals are eligible to participate in our program on a voluntary contribution basis:

- Individual aged 60 or older.
- Spouse or domestic partner who participates in the Silver Platters Program, with their spouse or domestic partner, who is age 60 or older.
- Disabled adult, who resides at home with an eligible older individual, participating in the Silver Platters Program.

The following forms are required to be filled out and returned to the Outagamie County Nutrition Program to receive vouchers:

- Silver Platters Registration Form
- Voucher Order Form

The *Registration Form* and *Voucher Order Form* can be requested by calling the ADRC at 920-832-5178 or emailing [adrc@outagamie.org](mailto:adrc@outagamie.org).

Voucher tickets will be mailed to you once the required paperwork is received at the ADRC Office. When you receive your voucher tickets, an additional *Voucher Order Form* and self-addressed envelope will be provided if you wish to order more.

**Outagamie County Nutrition Program has a limited number of vouchers available annually. Voucher request approval will be dependent on program funding and voucher availability. Each voucher covers the meal cost of \$8.00. This includes gratuity to the food provider.**

**Outagamie County Nutrition Program is required to provide you with the opportunity to contribute to the cost of this service. The suggested contribution is \$3.00 per meal. Contributions to help offset the cost of meals are essential to maintaining nutrition services for our community's older adults.**



### ***Program Guidelines***

*Voucher Guidelines:* Approved participants are the only person allowed to redeem a voucher. **ID will be required to show proof of participant and signature is required to redeem voucher. Vouchers may not be borrowed or lent to others regardless of eligibility. The restaurant will not divide meal portions.**

*When using Silver Platters Voucher:* Present voucher when ordering meal. The Silver Platters approved menu will be presented.

*Program Approved Menu:* Participants of the Silver Platters program must order from the program approved menu. Items which are ordered in addition to or from an unapproved menu will be at the participants cost.

*Suggested Contribution:* The suggested contribution is \$3.00 per meal. Participants will not be denied a meal if unable to contribute. Contributions can be mailed to Outagamie County Nutrition Program, 320 S Walnut, Appleton, WI 54911.

Please note: Restaurants are unable to accept contributions for the Nutrition Program.

*Voluntary contributions to the Silver Platters program can be returned with voucher order form.*

Suggested Contribution per voucher is \$3.00

4 vouchers -Suggested Contribution \$12.00

5 vouchers- Suggested Contribution is \$15.00

*Expiration Date:* Vouchers expire at the end of each calendar year. Expired vouchers will not be accepted nor refunded.

*Our Intent:* The intent of the program is to provide healthy and balanced meals, along with the opportunity for socialization. "Take Out" meals are not available.
