Annual Meeting Minutes - September 28, 2023

President Kramer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Town of Bovina Hall. He introduced the Outagamie County Drainage Board members. Present: Al Kramer, Greg Nettekoven, Jason Van Eperen, Mike Van Asten. Gerald Vander Heiden

Also present: Nancy Christensen, Administrative Assistant; Jeremy Freun, Land Conservation Department; Others present: Alan Van Straten, Randy Conradt, Tom Dawes, Pat Van Straten, Ryan Carlson

Kramer informed those present the Board meets every first Tuesday of the month at 8:30 a.m. at the Town of Osborn, W3389 County Road EE, Seymour. Any concerns may come to this meeting and bring them before the Board or contact any member at any time. Minutes and agendas are posted on the Outagamie County website under the Land Conservation Department.

Minutes of the September 23, 2020 minutes –

Ryan Carlson moved, Pat Van Straten seconded to approve minutes as presented.

Presentation of projects completed and future projects –

Jeremy Freund, Outagamie County Land Conservation Department presented an overview of the Drainage District. There is an area north of US 76 by the sod far, approximately 2,700 feet that need to be dredge. Cost estimate is \$14,000. In the future, the pump will need to be replaced. Cost estimate \$25,000 - \$30,000. The pump would be out in the open, not in an enclosed building.

Trees were cleaned out on Hooymen, more could be done. There are trees by pump that need to be removed.

Al Van Straten asked how far down stream can the Drainage Board go out of the district? Kramer: If there is a stream restriction that is causing a back up, we can go in and remove it. Generally we will contact the property owner and ask them to remove it and/or work with them.

The culvert off of Boelter Road with the lift gate was replaced with a screw type gate.

Ryan Carlson agreed to continue doing the maintenance of the pump for 2024.

2022-2023 Financial Report

The ending fund balance as of December 31, 2022 was \$14,480. Special assessments received in 2023 were \$10,569 plus dividend of \$5 for a total operating funds available of \$25,054. Expenses through September 20, 2023 are \$1,368 resulting in a fund balance of \$23,687. Al Van Straten moved, seconded by Pat Van Straten to accept the Financial Report as presented.

2023 Special Assessment Rate payable in 2024 -

Ryan Carlson moved, seconded by Pat Van Straten to recommend keeping the 2023 assessment rate the same as 2022 which was \$5 per acre and \$50 minimum for 10 acres or less. Voice vote: motion carried.

2024 annual meeting will be held around the same time.

Ryan Carlson moved, seconded by Al Van Straten to adjourn at 8:11 p.m.
