NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at a special election to be held in the Village of Greenville, wards, and election district of Outagamie County, on Tuesday, March 2, 2021, the following officers are to be elected:

VILLAGE PRESIDENT

ONE VILLAGE PRESIDENT, for the term expiring on April 17, 2023:

VILLAGE TRUSTEE

FOUR VILLAGE TRUSTEES, for the terms expiring on April 18, 2022; and for terms expiring on April 17, 2023:

- The four trustees elected at the first election shall serve the following terms:
 - The term of office of the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes in the first election shall be two years ending with the spring election in 2023.
 - The term of office of the two candidates receiving the remaining votes shall be for one year ending with the spring election in 2022.
 - Thereafter, the term of office of all Trustees shall be two years with two trustees being elected in even numbered years and two trustees being elected in odd numbered years.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, that the first day to circulate nomination papers is January 20, 2021, and the final day for filing nomination papers is 5:00 p.m. on Monday, February 8. Candidates for the seats of Village President and Village Trustee file with the Village of Greenville Clerk.

Acceptable Photo ID will be required to vote at this election. If you do not have a photo ID, you may obtain a free ID for voting from the Division of Motor Vehicles.
