The Board meets pursuant to adjournment, and is called to order by Chairperson Nooyen at 7:00 p.m. by teleconference.



Support pending legislation that would authorize city councils and the boards of villages, counties, school districts, and technical college districts to satisfy their legal obligation to publish the proceedings of regular and special meetings by posting a copy of the proceedings in a public place, or electronically placing a copy of the proceedings on the Internet site maintained by the respective governmental unit, and support pending legislation that would permit a governmental unit to discontinue publishing proceedings of regular and special meetings by providing the jurisdictional newspaper 180 days' notice of discontinuation and by following the additional procedures noted on this resolution and on the attachments.



8. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Resolution No. 128—2020-21 – Finance Committee. Authorize and approve transferring the following County Executive line items: \$15,000 from Salaries and \$2,280 from Fringes to Purchased Services in order to fund outsourced communications work, as noted in the attached fiscal note.
- B. Resolution No. 129—2020-21 -- Finance Committee. Support pending legislation that would require the Wisconsin Elections Commission to reimburse counties and municipalities for certain costs incurred in the administration of special primaries and special elections for governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state, state treasurer, attorney general, state superintendent of public instruction, justice of the supreme court, court of appeals judge, circuit court judge, state senator, state representative to the assembly, and district attorney.
- C. Resolution No. 130—2020-21 -- Finance Committee. Approve and adopt the (attached) updated Article III, Section 22-112 of the Outagamie County Investment Policy.
- D. Resolution No. 131—2020-21 – Public Safety Committee. Authorize and approve increasing the following line items in the Law Enforce. Communic. cost centers: Intergovernmental Revenue \$5,000, Salaries \$2,190, and Travel/Training \$2,810 to be used for Telecommunicator Emergency Medical Dispatch (EMD) training and EMD recertification tests, as noted on the attached fiscal note.
- E. Resolution No. 132—2020-21 – Public Safety Committee. Authorize and approve transferring the following line items: \$37,700 from the Small Department Vacation/Sick Leave Payout fund to the County Family Court Commissioner line items: Salaries (\$27,100) and Fringe Benefits (\$10,600), and increase the General Funds Applied, Fund Balance Applied \$37,700, and decrease the General Fund, Committed Fund Balance for Small Depts. Vac/Sick Payouts \$37,700 and increase the General Fund, Fund Balance Unassigned \$37,700, as noted on the attached fiscal note.
- F. Resolution No. 133—2020-21 -- Public Safety Committee. Oppose pending legislation that would revoke extended supervision, parole, or probation if a person is charged with a crime, and oppose further limits on ability for expungement of a crime.
