

An Election to fill the unexpired term for the Multi-Jurisdictional Judge for the City of Seymour and Town of Seymour.

WHEREAS, the incumbent Multi-Jurisdictional Judge for the City of Seymour and Town of Seymour passed away. Wisconsin Statute 8.50(4)(fm) states: "A permanent vacancy in the office of municipal judge may be filled by temporary appointment of the municipal governing body, or, if the judge is elected under s. [755.01 \(4\)](#), jointly by the governing bodies of all municipalities served by the judge. The office shall then be permanently filled by special election. A person so elected shall serve for the residue of the unexpired term."

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JEFF KING, Clerk for Outagamie County, Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute 8.50(4)(fm), a special election shall be called by the County Clerk, Tuesday, April 4, 2023, in conjunction with the regularly scheduled 2023 Spring Election, to fill the vacancy of the Multi-jurisdictional Judge for the City of Seymour and Town of Seymour. A primary, if necessary, will be held on Tuesday, February 21, 2023. The election will be held to fill the remaining term of the seat, which expires on April 30, 2024.

Circulation of nomination papers shall be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 3, 2023, in the office of the Outagamie County Clerk, 320 S. Walnut Street, Appleton, WI 54911.

The polling locations for this election shall be as follows: City of Seymour residents; City of Seymour Municipal Building, 328 N. Main Street, Seymour, WI 54165. Town of Seymour residents; Crystal Spring Golf Course, N8055 French Road, Seymour, WI 54165.
